

Disposal and Environmental Regulations

Battery Act:

Discharged batteries are special waste and should not be put into the domestic waste!

Dear Customer, as consumer you are obliged to return flat batteries/rechargeable batteries free of charge to a suitable collection point (trade, municipality).

If you do not know where you may dispose of the product, please, contact your municipality, your local waste management provider, or your seller. You can also return used batteries that you have purchased from SatMARS or devices manufactured or sold for SatMARS directly to us. Please contact us via our contact form on the website to notify us accordingly

Electronic Equipment Act:

Electronic Equipment is special waste and should not be put into the domestic waste!

Dear Customer, As owner of an electrical or electronic product, you are obliged by law to place it in a collection separate from that for unsorted domestic waste. The regulation regards to all electronic and electric devices, no matter how old these are.

The separate collection and recycling of your waste equipment at the time of disposal will help to conserve natural resources and ensure that it is recycled in a manner that protects human health and the environment.

You can return used devices that you have purchased from SatMARS or devices manufactured or sold for SatMARS directly to us. Please contact us via our contact form on the website to notify us accordingly.

But before disposing it, please make sure of two things:

- Make sure that any personal data on the device has been removed or deleted on your own responsibility.
- Please ensure that the flat battery/ rechargeable battery has been removed from the device if not enclosed.

The symbol of the waste bin with a cross through it indicates that this electronic device must be collected separately. If you do not know where you may dispose of the product, please, contact your municipality, your local waste management provider, or your seller.
