

Disposal and environmental regulations

Battery law:

Old batteries must not be disposed of with household waste! Consumers are obliged to take batteries to a suitable collection point in the municipality or to a retailer. They can be returned there free of charge.

Used batteries that you have purchased from SatMARS or devices manufactured or sold for SatMARS can be returned directly to us. Please contact us via our contact form on the website to register and arrange this with us.

Electronic Equipment Act:

Old electronic devices do not belong in household waste.

Dear customers, as the owner of an old electrical or electronic device, you are legally obliged to dispose of it separately from unsorted household waste. The regulation applies to all electronic and electrical appliances, no matter how old.

The separate collection of these devices is intended on the one hand to ensure the reuse and recycling of valuable parts of the device and on the other hand to help avoid negative consequences for the environment during disposal.

Systems that you have purchased directly from SatMARS or from dealers must be handed in directly to SatMARS for disposal! Please contact us via our contact form on the website to register and arrange this with us. Please ensure two things before disposing of an old device:

- Please ensure that all personal data stored on the old device to be disposed of has been deleted by you on your own responsibility.
- Please also ensure that used batteries and accumulators that are not enclosed in the old appliance have been separated from the appliance before disposal.
